RESOLUTION 2008-2009-01


SENATE BILL NO. 1816 provides that the board of county commissioners may declare a seven day burn ban which is renewable every seven days.

WHEREAS: A request has been made by the Carter County Fire Chiefs Association that the Board of Carter County Commissioners invoke a seven day county wide burn ban.

WHEREAS: Any resolution passed by a board of county commissioners under authority of this subsection shall be effective immediately upon passage of the resolution. Notice of the resolution shall be submitted to the Forestry Division of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, all local news media, local law enforcement officials, and the state headquarters of the Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Department of Wildlife Conservation on the day of passage of the resolution. Evidence of publication or posting as provided in this paragraph shall be maintained by the county.

THEREFORE: The Board of the Carter County Commissioners does hereby resolve to implement a seven day county wide burn ban which could be renewable in seven days.


